Thank you for the information that you provided to the Board of Registration of Psychologists. A copy of your complaint, referenced above, was sent to Erick Medina who was required to respond in writing and did so. After considering this matter on August 13, 2021, the Board recommended that Mr. Medina be fined in the amount of one thousand dollars for his unlicensed practice.

Please be advised that on November 22, 2022, the Board counter-signed a Consent Agreement for a fine ("Agreement") in order to resolve the complaint referenced above. Therefore, as of the effective date of the Agreement, November 22, 2022, the Board has fined Mr. Medina which is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
